#### Minutes -

- Mrs Price introduced the School Council. Stating that they usually meet once per half term but sometimes they meet more if there were issues to discuss.
- Mrs Price asked if there were any issues around school. The children said that staff and
  pupils talked during choir and they don't like this. Mrs Price said she would speak to Staff
  about this in morning briefing and pupils in assembly
- They have asked why they couldn't bring toys to school and Mrs Price clarified the rules. She also explained that toys might get lost or broken if they were brought into school.
- They talked about pupils sometimes swearing in school, Mrs Price said that she would talk about this in assembly and remind the pupils about the UNICEF rights which include Respect.
- Pupils then asked what would happen if staff swore at pupils. Mrs Price explained that there
  is an online system in school where staff can record any allegations about low level concerns
  about staff and that this was called Confide. The pupils were interested in this. Mrs Price
  explained that My Concern was another system which helps pupils stay safe. Mrs. Price then
  said at the next meeting pupils will get the chance to review the child on child abuse policy.
